

# COVID-19 Vaccine Suspension of Out-of-Network Limits for Texas Medicaid and CHIP

## Background

The COVID-19 vaccine is a benefit of Texas Medicaid and CHIP programs. Coverage of the COVID-19 vaccine is mandatory whether the vaccine is administered by an in-network or out-of-network provider. As a reminder, there is no cost sharing for CHIP as this is a preventative service.

#### What is new

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) will not enforce out-of-network usage limits for the administration of approved COVID-19 vaccines. Participation **is limited to enrolled** Texas Medicaid and CHIP providers. Payments to out-of-network providers must be made within required timeframes of the <u>Uniform</u> Managed Care Claims Manual (UMCCM) found in chapter 2.
